We have classes for all levels, beautiful ribbons, high point awards, and a special Cynthia Pennell Memorial Horsemanship Award Buckle!

GENERAL RULES & GUIDELINES

Entries* (of at least one class or more and office fee) are due one week prior to competition to avoid \$15 late fee. You may enter additional classes at time of show for no late fee if you have already entered by deadline for at least one class. Course maps and draw will be posted at each walk through. Obstacles will be judged with 3 refusals per obstacle per the judges discretion. No abuse to any horse or animal on property will be tolerated. Offenders will be asked to leave and will forfeit any entry fees or winnings. Judge may dismiss a horse or rider for safety reasons when well being of horse, rider or spectators is at risk. All youth must be accompanied by an adult. No stallions are to be ridden by youth. Attire should match tack, i.e. western attire for western tack, english attire for english tack. Western hats may be substituted by a helmet. No training devices allowed. Bosals permitted. Same horse may be ridden in different classes with different riders, but not in same class with different riders. All dogs must be kept on leash and away from the riding areas. No dogs on or near the course at any time.

All competitors are welcome to arrive early!

SATURDAY CLASSES

Class eligibility is as of January 1, 2019

COURSE ONE

IN-HAND (Does not count towards high point) - Open to all exhibitors.

TRUE ROOKIE (Does not count towards high point) - Any rider who has not competed in a competitive trail and/or obstacle course prior to January 1, 2019. Exhibitor may not have received payment for riding, training, assisting in training, or showing horses, nor received payment directly or indirectly for conducting a seminar or clinic within the past 5 years.

WARM-UP CLASS (Does not count towards high point) - Open to all exhibitors.

TRAIL EXPLORER HORSE & RIDER (Does not count towards high point) - Horse and Rider combo may have never won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a trail and/or obstacle class together. Exhibitor may not have received payment for riding, training, assisting in training, or showing horses, nor received payment directly or indirectly for conducting a seminar or clinic within the past 5 years.

NOVICE RIDER (Class/Division) - Any rider who has not won first place three times (in any trail class and/or obstacle class with 3 or more riders). Exhibitor may not have received payment for riding, training, assisting in training, or showing horses, nor received payment directly or indirectly for conducting a seminar or clinic within the past 5 years.

YOUTH ages 17 & Under

MID TIMER RIDER ages 18-59

OLD TIMER RIDER ages 60 and over

COURSE TWO

OPEN (Class/Division) - Open to any exhibitor.

AMATEUR (Class/ Division) - Exhibitor may not have received payment for riding, training, assisting in training, or showing horses, nor received payment directly or indirectly for conducting a seminar or clinic within the past 5 years.

INTERMEDIATE (Class/Division) - Any rider not eligible for Novice Rider, but has not won more than 3 class championships in a multiple day show in a trail and/or obstacle competition. Exhibitor may not have received payment for riding, training, assisting in training, or showing horses, nor received payment directly or indirectly for conducting a seminar or clinic within the past 5 years.

Cynthia Pennell Memorial Horsemanship Award **NEVER WON A BUCKLE CLASS (Does not count towards high point)**
Any Novice or Intermediate rider that has never won a buckle at a trail or obstacle competition. Exhibitor may not have received payment for riding, training, assisting in training, or showing horses, nor received payment directly or indirectly for conducting a seminar or clinic. **Rider who rides this class both days and has the highest cumulative score wins a special Cynthia Pennell Memorial Horsemanship Award Buckle!**

PONY EXPRESS COURSE

TIMED & JUDGED (Does not count towards high point) - Open to all exhibitors. Must have a team of 3 riders that each perform a specific portion of the course.

BAREBACK COURSE

BAREBACK CLASS (Does not count towards high point): Open to all riders. Rider must compete without saddle or saddle pad.

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TRAIL CLASS DESCRIPTIONS - \$20 ENTRY FEES

Class eligibility is as of January 1, 2019

SUNDAY CLASSES

COURSE THREE

ROOKIE HORSE (Does not count towards high point) - Any horse who has not competed in a competitive trail and/or obstacle class prior to January 1, 2019.

GREEN HORSE - Any horse that has not won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a trail and/or obstacle competition.

JUNIOR HORSE ages 5 and under

SENIOR HORSE ages 6 and over

MARE CLASS

GELDING CLASS

COURSE FOUR

CHALLENGER HORSE - Any horse not eligible for GREEN HORSE, but has not won more than 3 blue ribbons in trail and/or obstacle competition.

COMPETITOR HORSE - Any horse not eligible for CHALLENGER HORSE class.

Cynthia Pennell Memorial Horsemanship Award **NEVER WON A BUCKLE CLASS (Does not count towards high point)**

Any Novice or Intermediate rider that has never won a buckle at a trail or obstacle competition. Exhibitor may not have received payment for riding, training, assisting in training, or showing horses, nor received payment directly or indirectly for conducting a seminar or clinic. **Rider who rides this class both days and has the highest cumulative score wins a special Cynthia Pennell Memorial Horsemanship Award Buckle!**

FREESTYLE COURSE

OPEN | AMATEUR | INTERMEDIATE | NOVICE

ALL CLASSES - Open gate, two circles left lead, two circles right lead, stop and back up. Plus rider chooses any 5 out of additional obstacle list. Rider must tell judge prior to starting which obstacles they will perform. These classes are held in the main arena.

HIGH POINT AWARDS (Must designate one division. See class descriptions for division eligibility.)

OPEN RIDER - Rider with highest cumulative points wins. *Eligible classes include:* Open Class, Rider Age Class, Horse Age Class, Horse Gender Class, Horse Skill Class & Freestyle Open Class.

AMATEUR RIDER - Rider with highest cumulative points wins. *Eligible classes include:* Amateur Class, Rider Age Class, Horse Age Class, Horse Gender Class, Horse Skill Class & Freestyle Amateur Class.

INTERMEDIATE RIDER - Rider with highest cumulative points wins. *Eligible classes include:* Intermediate Class, Rider Age Class, Horse Age Class, Horse Gender Class, Horse Skill Class & Freestyle Intermediate Class.

NOVICE RIDER - Rider with highest cumulative points wins. *Eligible classes include:* Novice Class, Rider Age Class, Horse Age Class, Horse Gender Class, Horse Skill Class & Freestyle Novice Class.
